



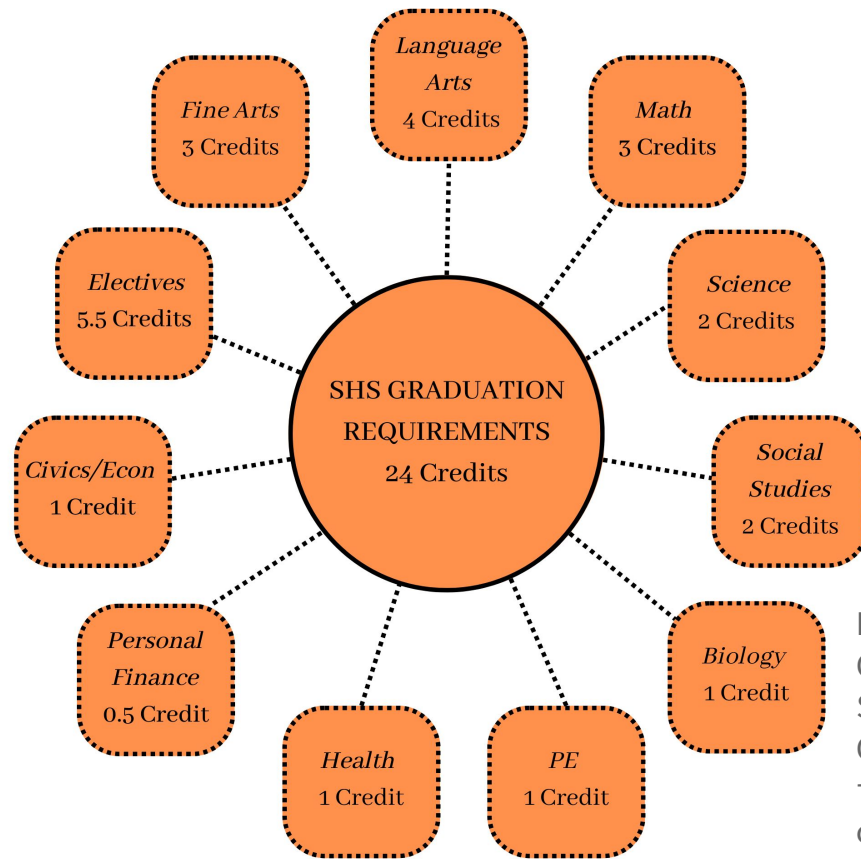
# Forecasting

**For the 2024-25 School Year**

- **FORECASTING** is the process of selecting classes you wish to take during the next school year.
- It is a plan that prepares you for college, work, and your goals for the future.
- During high school, you have the opportunity to make many choices and decisions that will impact your future. Forecasting is one of these opportunities.

- The classes you take in high school determine the post-secondary opportunities available to you.
- More credits and more rigorous classes (*Honors or Dual Credit/college credit*) usually mean a greater number of schools you can apply to.

# Dual Credit Classes at SHS (44+ credits)

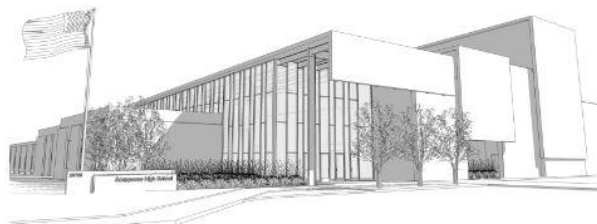
- The school's master schedule (*what classes are offered and when*) is built around the classes students forecast for.

# How do I pick my classes?

*Everyone will complete a Google Form where they will choose their core classes and electives. Please make sure that you check in with your parents before you submit your forecasting!*

**English :** Highly recommend that you consider Honors English if you have a “B” or above in your current English class.

**Math:** Your current math teacher will send their recommendations directly to your high school counselor.

**Science:** If you plan to take Adv Algebra II next year, forecast for Biology instead of Physical Science.

**Electives:** Look through the Course Description Guide to view your elective options. Make sure to give us multiple choices in case one elective doesn't fit in your schedule.
